Cameras and alarms systems are really a requirement at any transmission facilities today.

In national news SBE General Counsel, Chris Imlay will be the guest during a special SBE webinar this week. On Thursday, December 3 at 2:00 pm EST, Chris will discuss the latest developments on technical regulatory topics, spectrum allocations and broadcast auxiliary spectrum issues that affect the broadcast industry. The webinar is free to all members and \$50 for non-members. Unlike our other webinars, it will be done via Zoom. Registration is required and the Zoom link will be sent to you.

Announced in November, the new SBE ATSC3 Specialist certification exams will be available to take during the February 2021 exam period. The deadline to apply is December 31. More information and the exam application are available at the SBE website, certification section.

The SBE Board of Directors have elected to keep annual membership dues at current levels for a third consecutive year in 2021.

The Society of Broadcast Engineers has developed a response to the ongoing concern about new technical talent choosing broadcasting as a career by creating the Technical Professional Training Program (TPTP). As technology and the average age and tenure of technical professionals advances (as shown in the annual SBE Compensation Survey), there is concern to adequately fulfill the technical staffing needs in the long term. In the past, part-time employees and smaller market stations served as a training ground for new talent. Streamlining the workforce, consolidation of ownership and a reduction in the electronic technology programs at trade schools and colleges have culminated in a looming crisis. The SBE is uniquely positioned to provide a solution.

Drawing on existing SBE programs, the society has assembled a valuable service to the broadcast industry going forward. The goal: Training new entrants to the field of broadcast technology. There are four elements that combine to create the new Technical Professional Training Program.
