On a more positive note, we also named Frequency Coordinator Jim Baird as Chapter Engineer of the Year. Congrats Jim, well deserved!

In national news the Society of Broadcast Engineers has elevated SBE Certification Director Megan Clappe to the membership rank of Fellow. The SBE Board of Directors elected her at its meeting held May 10. Ms. Clappe started working for the SBE in September 2003. She was originally hired as the certification assistant and receptionist where she worked with previous Certification Director (and SBE Fellow) Linda Baun. In June 2006, Linda left the SBE for a position with the Wisconsin Broadcasters Association, and Megan was promoted to SBE certification director. Megan's daily duties include working with the SBE Certification Committee to operate and grow the SBE Certification Program, which includes implementing and maintaining certifications to match those needs. She coordinates testing with proctors and follows up after exams are administered. In all, she is tasked with keeping track of more than 5,000 certifications and recertifications.

Upcoming webinars start June 17, 2021 at 2 p.m. The SBE RF Safety Course provides an updated overview of RF radiation issues and practices for broadcasters. The course is designed for broadcast station personnel, including chief and assistant chief engineers, transmitter site engineers, ENG and SNG maintenance personnel and management who need to have an understanding of RF safety issues and regulations.

Then on June 24, the 2021 IP Networking Series continues with Module 6: Cybersecurity – Practical Implementation. Part 6 of the series will focus on understanding the practical implementation of cybersecurity. Topics to be covered include network design for security, physical security, Ethernet switch port security, encryption and network ports.
