Radio, television and recording consoles continue to evolve bringing increasing resolution and processing horsepower as well as new features and innovations.

### **Information about the February and March Chapter 70 Meetings**

Our February meeting is likely to be slipped from our normal day to Wednesday, February 11. We are tentative scheduled for a tour of the facilities at the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame. Their schedule does not accommodate our normal meeting day. At this time I'm not sure if our food and meeting will be at the Rock Hall or somewhere nearby. The program will be presented by Cam Eicher of Logitek Audio Consoles. Logitek is a manufacturer of Integrated Console Routing systems. Their presentation focuses on a new form of studio audio routing and control. They'll talk about implementing a routing system that uses small, local audio routers in each studio location and interconnecting those routers with a fiber optic audio network. Control comes from control surfaces made to look like "Standard" broadcast consoles, automation system PCs or Logitek's own scripting language. It is an entirely new way to think about studio design and layout that results in an easier to maintain, more flexible facility. More details in the next newsletter.

The program for our Tuesday, March 9<sup>th</sup> meeting will be presented by Maxine Taylor of Calrec Audio in England. Calrec has gotten a lot of press lately as networks install Calrec consoles in some of their facilities and trucks. Maxine will bring us up to date on Calrecs latest audio consoles and their Hydra audio networking system. Unfortunately I still have not identified a location for the March meeting so I'm looking for a facility to volunteer.
