SBE Agreement with U.S. Department of Defense on Spectrum Sharing

The U.S. Air Force plans to construct new satellite tracking stations in a number of U.S. locations that would use spectrum in the 2025 -2110 MHz band.

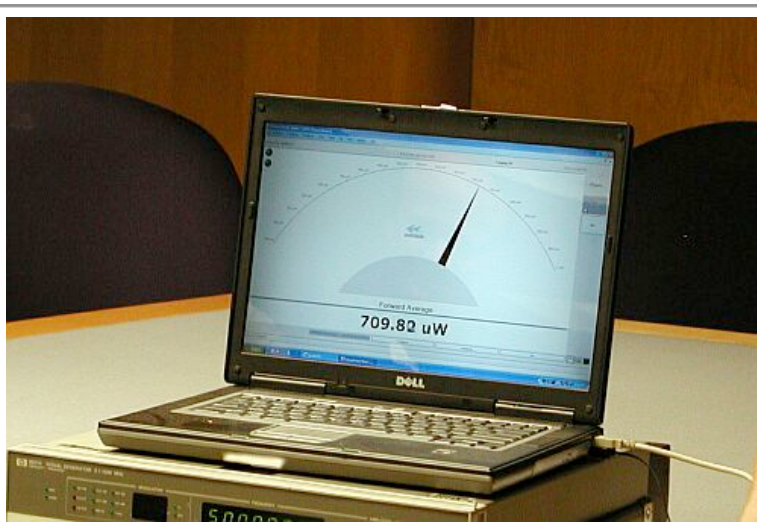


