As you know I've recently re-assumed the role of Northern Ohio SBE Frequency Coordinator—below one gigahertz. And you probably know that I am no newcomer to this endeavor.

For sure a reasonable amount of time has passed since the "early days" of coordination but I remain hopeful to once again be able to provide the Cleveland market, and in deed all of Northern Ohio, a vital, accurate and up-to-date database. **<u>But, I need your help</u>**.

If you would take the time from your busy schedules to review, and assemble if necessary, a list of <u>all frequen-</u> <u>cies</u> (below 1 GHz) actively in use at your facility, and email that list to me, I would be most appreciative.

From my experience, the process of listing active fre-

quencies will also provide a list of retired or un-used frequencies. I need to know that information as well. My intention is to edit/update my database of yesteryear, making it reflective of today's wireless activity. Be especially careful to list all low power wireless microphone frequencies.

With the DTV transition, homeland security and expanded 700MHz band activities, many of these wireless mics are at risk. What was once a very active 450 band, has been somewhat retired, so I need to know if you still maintain activities in this band. I know I'm preaching to the chore here, so please understand my intentions. I really do need your help!
