A final offering...DID YOU KNOW??? Jamming cell phones and GPS equipment is against the law! In recent years, the number of websites offering "cell jammers" or similar devices designed to block communications and create a "quiet zone" in vehicles, schools, theaters, restaurants and other places has increased substantially. While these devices are marketed under different names, such as signal blockers, GPS jammers, or text stoppers, they have the same purpose. We (the FCC) remind and warn consumers that it is a violation of federal law to use a cell jammer or similar devices that intentionally block, jam, or interfere with authorized radio communications such as cell phones, police radar, GPS, and WiFi. Despite some marketers' claims, consumers cannot legally use jammers within the United States, nor can retailers lawfully sell them.


