SBE files against Safety Cast STA

SBE has filed comments with the FCC against an STA application submitted by the Safety Cast Corporation. Safety Cast has developed a device to be used in emergency vehicles that would broadcast an alert to vehicles in their path. The device emits a low power signal that interrupts broadcasts of FM and potentially AM radio stations being received in cars (and homes and offices) within approximately 1,000 feet of the on-coming emergency vehicles. 









