SBE will act as a clearing house, putting those who can offer help in touch with those who have requested it.


A special e-mail address has been established, <u>hurricanehelp@sbe.org</u>, so members in need, or others on their behalf, can contact the SBE National Office and relate their need. Those who can offer assistance are also asked to contact the National Office using the same e-mail address, to let us know what assistance they are able to offer. The National Office staff will contact members across the country that have offered their help, and put them in touch with those seeking assistance.

Assistance may be needed to provide temporary housing, clothing and personal items or possibly equipment or parts for station facilities that have sustained damage. People may also call the National Office at a special number, (317) 846-9092, or visit the SBE web site, <u>www.sbe.org</u> to offer help or report a need.

The Society of Broadcast Engineers is the professional organization for radio and television engineers and those in related fields. SBE has more than 5,700 members in 110 chapters across the United States. There are also members in 30 other countries. Most chapters meet monthly and offer educational programs and an opportunity to network with their peers.
