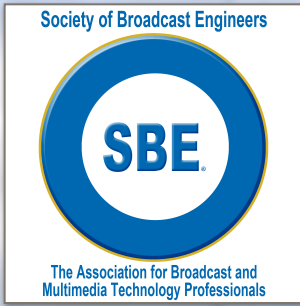

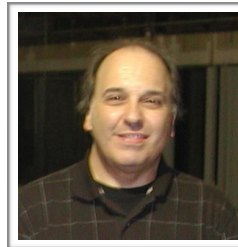
NOVEMBER MEETING INFO

There have been some newsworthy events occurring in the Radio Industry within the past month, namely the release of the FCC First Report and Order detailing the AM Revitalization Program. Without going into too much detail, it outlines a procedure for AM'ers to acquire FM Repeaters to fill in coverage, as well as elimination of the "ratchet rule" and other remediation aimed to help the AM Broadcaster. While some will argue it may be too little too late, others are saying it is about time and AM radio may never be in this position to help itself again. Either way, it will be interesting to see how this is implemented on a case by case basis and whether we'll see if any of the solutions outlined by the FCC put into practice by Northeast Ohio Broadcasters. You can read the full report by visiting the FCC.gov website. Much has already been written in other publications about it as well.
