Meeting time is as usual for June 14: Gathering at 6:30pm, with our SBE Chapter 70 Meeting at 7pm and Paul's presentation to follow.

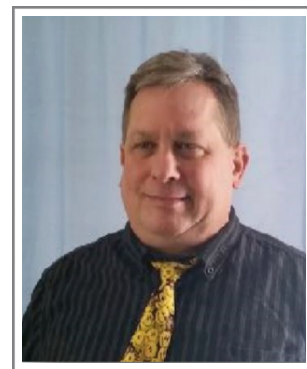
We will update you should this meeting become an in-person event, otherwise refer to the Zoom link.

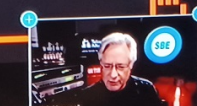
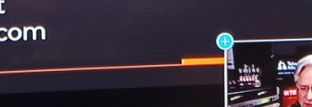
